All Georgia Youth ChalleNGe Program cadets attend academic classes Monday-Friday

Approximately 50% of GAYCP cadets who complete the program earn their academic credentials

General Education Diploma High School Academic Credit/Diploma

Our academic partner is Foothills Education Charter High School, an accredited, state-funded high school aligned with Georgia state standards.



Foothills offers our cadets a tuition free, self paced, online program monitored by certified faculty and staff.

FHECHS provides a blended learning model, which means teachers are available to assist cadets with the online content. Teachers are available through a virtual classroom where the cadets can connect directly with the teachers when assistance is needed.

Foothills provides an environment that is focused on the individual cadet's academic development and success.

Eligible cadets are able to accumulate high school credits that allows them to transfer back to their previous high school, or to remain with FECH until the completion of their diploma.

 X A cadet entering with sufficient credits (16+), could earn their high school diploma while in attendance at GAYCP.

The Georgia Youth ChalleNGe Program provides a "Second Chance" for Georgia's "at-risk youth, 16 to 18 years of age, who have not yet graduated from high school and who are willing to make a life-changing decision to volunteer for enrollment into this 22-week military-style residential program that offers the academic development they need to be successful in life. Our cadets also learn life skills that will make them more resilient and confident in their ability to negotiate the ever changing world with pride and self assurance. This life saving program will provide these cadets a positive pathway to a brighter future if they are willing to Rise 2 the ChalleNGe!
